SCHOOL DISTRICT LUNCH POLICY

A. F.W. Gilbert School

During the five coldest months (November-March) all students at F. W. Gilbert School will be eligible to remain for lunch with supervision provided by supervisors hired for the purpose as provided under the Public Schools Act Regulation 464/88R.

At the discretion of the Superintendent of Schools the provision of supervised lunch periods may be extended to a maximum of two (2) weeks prior to November and after March if the weather conditions are severe.

B. Transported Pupils

Pupils who are non-resident in the town of Pinawa are eligible to remain for lunch during the entire school year at both F.W. Gilbert Elementary and Pinawa Secondary School. The responsibility for this supervision rests with the Principal and school staff.

C. Resident Pupils

Resident students may remain for lunch for September, October, April, May and June as provided for by the Parent Advisory Council and School Principal. Supervision will be provided by supervisors hired and supervised by the school Principal. All costs for this lunch program will be recovered from the Parent Advisory Council by the school Principal.

D. Students who cause difficulties during lunch period will have their lunch privilege withdrawn.
